Thank you for choosing a Pathfinder camp! Please sign this form at the bottom of the page.

While this form may seem imposing, the purpose is to outline responsibilities and potential risks before you agree to participate. **Safety is our first concern and every activity is monitored to maintain our high standards.**

Pathfinder staff are mature professionals with prior experience working with youth. Staff has additional safety training/certification, including but not limited to: Red Cross Lifeguard Certification, CPR for the Professional Rescuer, First Aid, high and low ropes course facilitation, canoe instruction and water safety.

Camp activities may include cooperative games, low/high ropes challenge course, outdoor skills, ecology enrichment activities, nighttime activities, facilitated tree climbing, canoeing and swimming. We believe the risks to be minimal. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us.

- I am aware that participation in a Pathfinder Program exposes my child to the risks of injury associated with physical activity.
- Participation in Pathfinder activities isn't mandatory. I (my child) have freely chosen to participate. I acknowledge that at any time my child has the right NOT to participate in or discontinue participation in an activity with which s/he is not comfortable.
- The entire responsibility for safety is not the camp counselor's. Campers, too, have a responsibility. I/my child agree to follow the rules and safety procedures established and to obey Pathfinder staff.
- While some accommodations are available, I (for my child) understand that physical exertion may be part of camp.
- I understand that Pathfinder will make every effort to contact me in case of an emergency pertaining to my child.
- If I am unable to be reached, Pathfinder will try to contact an alternate adult listed on page 1. Pathfinder has my permission to secure medical attention for my child in the event of an emergency.
- I understand that I am responsible for any costs involved should my child become injured.
- I give permission for my child to participate in field trips taken in Pathfinder designated vehicles.
- I give permission for the use of photographs of my child by Pathfinder for promotional purposes.
- I have received, read, and understand the parent information distributed, including the policies of the camp (page 6) in which my child is enrolled. I also agree to and understand the policies on registration and payments for services as presented to me.
- By signing this Liability Waiver, I agree and acknowledge that I may be giving up important legal rights and remedies for myself, my child named herein, and our heirs, successors and assigns.
- I have and do hereby Release and Forever Discharge Pathfinder, Inc., its employees, the site where the camp is taking place as well as their agents, employees and director (herein collectively "Pathfinder, Inc.") from any and all liability, actions, causes of action, claims, and demands of any nature whatsoever which we now or may have as a result of our participation in this program. ### Outdoor Adventurers - Day Camp Information

- Day Camp is 9:00 am to 4:30 pm on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, at DaySpring.
- Early drop-off and late pick-up are available. Please see page 2 for times and fees.
- Thursday is a late day with an evening program and campfire. Campers must be picked up by 9:00 pm (or can be picked up by 5:30 pm if you choose not to participate in the evening program).
- Day Camp fees include lunch and a snack each day. Campers should eat breakfast before arrival.
- Dinner will be provided on Thursday (if they stay for the evening program).
- Campers must provide their own towels, swimsuits, change of clothes, sunscreen, and water bottle.

### Outdoor Adventurers or Trailblazers - Overnight Camp Information

- Drop off for overnight campers is Monday morning between 8:00 am and 9:00 am. Pick up is Friday evening between 4:30 pm and 5:30 pm.
- Fees listed include both program fees, meals and lodging. Overnight fees include meals from lunch on Monday through lunch on Friday. Campers should eat breakfast before arrival on Monday.
- Campers will stay in one of DaySpring's Youth Cabins, separated by gender, and chaperoned by trained Pathfinder facilitators.
- A complete packing list will be provided upon registration but campers must provide their own bedding, clothes for the week, personal toiletries, etc.

### Pathfinder Camp Policies

- **Safety is always our first concern!** We expect all campers to follow all safety instructions.
- Campers will be **supervised at all times** by Pathfinder facilitators.
- Campers may use site phones with approval of their counselors (**only during free times**) and calls should be collect or credit card. We don't encourage the use of personal cell phones by campers. Pathfinder is happy to relay any messages from parents to their children. Any cell phones campers bring will be kept by Pathfinder facilitators during the day.
- Pathfinder programs are **smoke-free environments**; smoking is prohibited in all buildings.
- Use or possession of **alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs** is prohibited for all campers. Campers caught with any of these substances will be sent home immediately.
- If misbehavior results in a decision to send a child home, there will be **no refund of fees**. If a camper is sent home due to injury or illness, the refund will be pro-rated for the length of stay.
- **Snack foods** may not be kept in campers' rooms but may be stored in the common room, in tight-closing containers.
- Soda isn't available during programming or meal times.
- **Pathfinder's Liability Waiver and Medical Release forms must be completed by every child attending**. During camp, the waivers will be on site and kept in a location known and accessible to all adults present. They then become the property of Pathfinder, Inc.
- Parents/Guardians may visit the site where the camp is taking place before or during their child's camp with prior notification. Special arrangements may need to be made and additional costs may be incurred. We encourage parents to contact us directly for any other information desired.
